

## **UIC World Security Congress 2010**

**Istanbul 21 – 23 April 2010**

### **Information sheet: technological exhibition**

The UIC World Security Congress 2010, the 6th UIC security congress, will be held from Wednesday 21 April 2010 to Friday 23 April 2010 at the Sheraton Hotel in Istanbul (Sheraton Istanbul Atakoy, Sahilyolu Atakoy Bakirkoy, Istanbul, Turkey 34158) at the invitation of Turkish Railways (TCDD).

A technological exhibition (stands presenting various technologies) will be held for the duration of the congress.

Participants will arrive on Tuesday 20 April 2010 during the day and a welcome cocktail will be organised in the evening, when it will be possible to register for the congress.

Wednesday 21 April 2010 will consist of plenary sessions after an official opening plenary session with the participation of the Turkish authorities and in the presence of journalists. In the evening TCDD will host an official dinner.

The morning of Thursday 22 April 2010 will be devoted to workshops on subjects such as security technologies suited to the specific features of railways and current research. The afternoon will be devoted to one or several technical visits upon the proposal of TCDD and partners of the congress, and UIC will be hosting an official dinner in the evening.

The morning of Friday 23 April 2010 will consist of plenary sessions: reports on workshops, the official closing session and approval of the final statement of the congress.

The area in which the technological exhibition will be held is adjacent to the hall in which the plenary session will take place, very close to the rooms provided for the workshops, and will be where participants will take all their breaks.

The fee for a stand at the technological exhibition has been set at €2000, tax excluded, and it includes the provision of approximately 6 m<sup>2</sup> of space delineated by panels. It provides two people with access to all the events in the congress and all the documents. Exhibitors are to pay for their own lodging. They may be requested to give a specific presentation in certain sessions, depending on which subjects are addressed.
