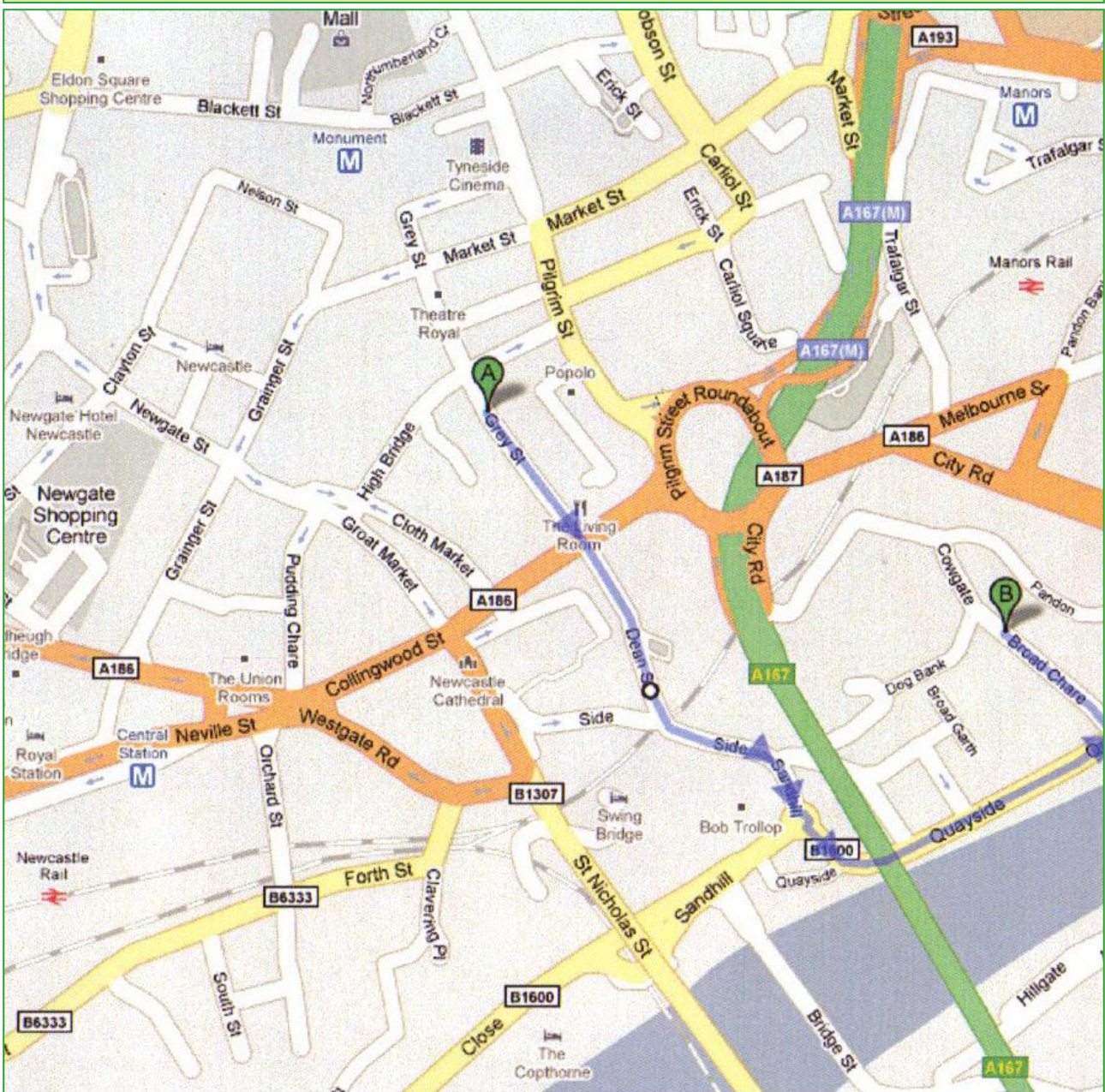

**B** – Café 21 (One Trinity Gardens, Broad Chare, Newcastle Upon Tyne, NE1 2HF)

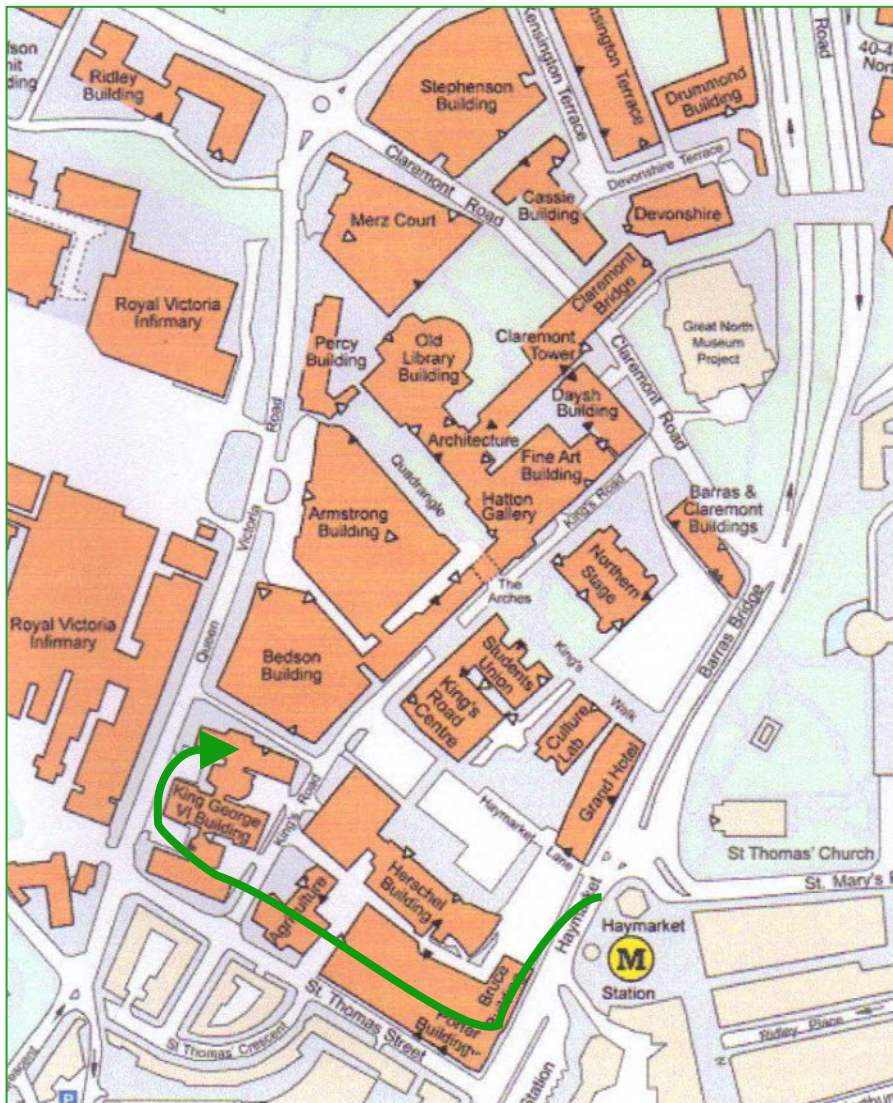


# MEETING VENUE
